Department of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of Uttar Pradesh (DoEF&CC) has approved an in-house Research Programme for supporting officers to carry-out in-house research in the domain of their work in the fields of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change.

The broad objective of this is:

- To address the local issues and challenges through a summary research with an objective to make contributions towards sustainable Environment.
- To harness vast experience of officers in finding solutions and improving overall efficiency of the department.

WHO CAN APPLY?

4. UP Forest Corporation

HOW TO APPLY?

Applications may be submitted in the form of a synopsis of research proposal in the following format (Max 1000 words)

- (i) Name & Designation
- (ii) Background
- (iii) Objective
- (iv) Methodology
- (v) Activity-wise timeline
- (vi) Activity-wise Financial Requirement
- (vii) Implementation potential of the research

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

(i) The synopsis of the proposed research shall be reviewed by the IRARC and the proposals shall be sanctioned on the basis of its recommendation.

(ii) Maximum financial support for a particular research will be ₹3.00 Lakh depending upon the merit of the proposal.

(iii) Mid-term and final review of the progress of research shall be done by IRARC.

(iv) The support of the in-house research shall be released in three installments as given below:-

a) 1st Installment

(50%) Immediately after sanction of the proposal.

b) 2nd Installment

(40%) After satisfactory Mid Term review by IRARC.

c) 3rd Installment

(10%) After satisfactory review of the final report by IRARC.

(v) The final report of the research must be of professional quality and must include Executive Summary, Findings of the research, Data analysis, Action Plan for implementation, Bibliography etc.

(vi) Support of local educational institutions and their students may be taken for data collection, analytics, writing and compilation works etc. on the basis of honorarium.

(vii) The sanctioned amount for the research shall be transferred to the Government account of the organization and shall be spent according to the provisions of Government Financial Rules.

(viii) The Utilization Certificate must be submitted to DoE in the prescribed format.
